Getting Around

Dublin Bus operates the public bus

network in Dublin city and county area. www.dublinbus.ie for details on services. LUAS (TRAM) Luas is a light rail transit

system that provides a safe, attractive service. It runs on two tramlines red and green. To view which line best serves you, please see the red and green lines outlined on the city map.

DART (TRAIN) The DART (Dublin Area Rapid Transport) is Dublin's main train service and stretches the full length of Dublin Bay, perfect for discovering towns and villages dotted along the coast.

Taxis Dublin taxis are plentiful and can be found at numerous ranks across the city. They can also be called for pickups. Dublin's taxi drivers often regard themselves as unofficial ambassadors to the city. Opinionated and sometimes more than a little un-p.c., they're nearly always worth listening to for tips on pubs,

Dublin Bikes Dublin is comparatively flat and relatively easy to negotiate on two wheels! DublinBikes is an Amsterdaminspired initiative designed to inspire locals and visitors alike to use bikes to move around the city. The service is excellent, the bikes are comfortable and sturdy, and come equipped with baskets for shopping and lights for night cycling. DublinBikes are free but you must register your details. Leap Card Dublin Leap card offers

integrated ticketing for Dublin Bus, LUAS, DART and commuter rail services! Simply buy your leap card, top it up with travel credit and away you go.
