

SIGHTS TO SEE

ACTIVITIES SUITABLE FOR KIDS, AVAILABLE AT THESE STOPS.

A NYBROPLAN Closest stop to the shopping district and many exclusive restaurants. From this stop it is also possible to catch a ferry to the inner and outer archipelago or go on an evening Dinner Cruise.

B VASA MUSEUM The warship Vasa is the world's only surviving 17th-century ship. This stop is also close to Nordiska museet - Sweden's largest museum of cultural history, and Junibacken - a real life storybook house for children.

C SKEPPSHOLMEN Once a military island now houses modern art at Moderna Museet, the Museum of Far Eastern Antiquities and the Swedish Museum of Architecture.

D DJURGÅRDEN At the amusement park Gröna Lund you can go for a ride on the world's biggest Zac-Spin coaster. Visit Aquaria Water Museum to discover the tropical sea with sharks. Spend some time at Skansen, where several Nordic animals are presented and about 150 historical buildings from the 18th, 19th, and early 20th centuries. Visit Liljevalchs where they show art and design, or the Museum of Spirits and Absolut Art Collection.

E CRUISE BERTH / VIKING LINE This is where many cruise ships visiting Stockholm are docked and also where the cruise ships to Finland arrive and depart.

F FOTOGRAFISKA At Fotografiska you can visit exhibitions by famous photographers. The museum shop, dedicated to the medium of photography, offers a wide assortment of postcards, photography books and collector's items.

G OLD TOWN A good starting point to explore the city's old town, the original heart of Stockholm. Here you'll find several souvenir shops and the Royal Palace. This stop is also the closest one to the hip district SoFo at Södermalm with restaurants, pubs and interesting boutiques.

H THE ROYAL PALACE This is the Swedish Royal family's official residence and you are welcome to visit the Royal Apartments, the Treasury and the Gustav III's Museum of Antiquities. Next to the Royal Palace is Stockholm Cathedral St. Nicolai, Storkyrkan, where several coronations have been held, the first in 1336. The church also housed the royal wedding of H.M King Carl XVI Gustaf and H.M Queen Silvia in 1976, followed by H.R.H Crown Princess Victoria and Prince Daniel Westling in June 2010.
