



# Daily Programme.

## From the Navigator.



Early this morning Queen Victoria made her approaches to the Malaga Pilot Station, embarked the local pilot and proceeded into the port before coming alongside her berth for the day. Later this evening we will let go all lines, proceed back out of the port and set various south westerly courses towards Gibraltar Rock and our next port call Gibraltar.

## In the port of Malaga, Spain.

Arrival Time: 8.00am

All Aboard Time: 5.30pm

Malaga is a port city, located in southern Spain, on the Costa del Sol on the northern side of the Mediterranean Sea. It lies at the feet of the Montes de Malaga, about 100 kilometres (62 miles) east of the Strait of Gibraltar and about 130 km (81 miles) to the north of Africa. Malaga is known for its high-rise hotels and resorts jutting up from yellow-sand beaches. Looming over that modern skyline are the city's two massive hilltop citadels, the Alcazaba and ruined Gibralfaro, remnants of Moorish rule. Malaga has more museums than any other city in Andalusia: over 30 at last count - and new ones are opening all the time. The opening of the Picasso Museum in 2003 triggered the city's cultural rebirth, and visitors are now flocking to this port city which boasts excellent transport, top-class cuisine and fascinating monuments, from Moorish and Roman times through to modern day - while retaining its authentic Andalusian feel. In addition to homage to the great Picasso, other great historic monuments include the imposing Baroque Cathedral, nicknamed La Manquita ("one-armed lady") because one of its towers was curiously left unbuilt, and the newly restored Roman theatre. High on the hill above the city is the Parador, which is situated in the Gibralfaro Castle. This is a wonderful place to have a long lunch in these fascinating surroundings, with panoramic views over Malaga city and out across the port to sea.

## Malaga city sightseeing hop on, hop off.

You can purchase tickets for the Malaga city sightseeing hop on, hop off bus tour at the Tour Office. Tickets will be on sale today. The Tour Office will be open from 8.00am to 10.00am and 4.00pm to 7.00pm on deck 1, midships in the Grand Lobby.

## Shuttle bus service.

There will be a continuous shuttle bus transfer service from Queen Victoria to Malaga town centre. Drop off point is by the Marina Square. The first bus will depart at 8.30am. The shuttle bus transfer will take approximately 15 minutes each way and is subject to local traffic conditions. The last shuttle bus to return to Queen Victoria will be at 5.00pm. We will not be able to accommodate everybody on the last bus, so we ask that you plan your day accordingly. There is no need to purchase tickets in advance as we will scan your Guest ID card when boarding. A maximum of two journeys will be charged per day; each additional journey for today will be free of charge. This service is chargeable for guests who booked Cunard Early Saver and Saver Fares. Adult Single \$6.00 per person (one way) and \$3.00 per child (one way). Guests who booked other fare types will not be charged for this shuttle bus transfer service. We anticipate queues during peak times, and so some guests may wish to consider using a local taxi to avoid waiting.

## Tonight's dress code: Informal.

Jacket required, tie optional for gentlemen, cocktail dress, stylish separates or equivalent for ladies. After 6.00pm, shorts and blue or worn denim (for men and women), sandals and sleeveless tops (for men) are not considered appropriate within the ship. Any guests wishing to dress more casually are welcome to dine in the Lido restaurants on deck 9 and relax in the Winter Garden, Yacht Club and on the open decks, but should not use other areas within the ship, including The Verandah restaurant, out of respect for their fellow guests. We ask guests to refrain from wearing swimwear and dressing gowns outside the spa and pool areas.

## Spanish IVA (VAT).

Spanish IVA (VAT) at a rate of 10% is payable on all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are located within 12 nautical miles in Spanish territorial waters (i.e. during the times when we are entering and exiting Spanish ports as well as the time we are alongside in Spanish ports). Prices displayed in our bars, restaurants and room service menus are exclusive of this tax, therefore an additional 10% will be added to all bar charges, select dining cover charges and room service charges whilst our ships are in Spanish territorial waters. The Spanish IVA (VAT) element will be itemised separately on your receipt.

## Health advice.

In order to prevent any incidences of viral gastroenteritis (diarrhoea and vomiting) on board, we would respectfully advise our guests to be careful with their personal hygiene, particularly hand washing during their time ashore. If eating and drinking ashore please look for an establishment that appears well maintained and clean and only consume food that has been freshly and thoroughly cooked. It is recommended that you take care when ordering salads which are often washed in local tap water and only drink water from unopened sealed bottles and without ice.

## Batteries

As part of Cunard's commitment to the environment, we have introduced a system for the disposal of expired batteries. Please hand them to your stateroom/suite steward(ess).

## Hand antibacterial units on the gangway.

We encourage all guests to assist us in maintaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial units that are located at the gangway.

## Alcohol bought ashore.

When purchasing alcohol ashore, please remember that this may be brought on board the ship for consumption in staterooms only and may not be taken into the public areas or on the open decks.

## Replenishing of stateroom towels.

Every day our oceans are burdened with the excessive use of detergents in laundering towels. We would like to be able to reduce this burden. If you would like to reuse your towels, please leave them on the towel rail. If you would like your towels to be replaced, please leave them on the floor.

## Postage.

For your convenience a concierge postal service is available for you to send letters and postcards at every port. The rate per postage item is \$1.60 for worldwide delivery from every port. Maximum weight per item is limited to 50g. If you have already purchased your own postage stamps you may leave the mail at the Purser's Office for posting. You will not be charged for postage which has already been correctly stamped by yourself. The deadline for sending mail is 2 hours before sailing when the ship is docked, and 3 hours prior if the ship is anchored and using tenders.

## Currency exchange.
