## From the Navigator.



This morning Queen Victoria finds herself lying quietly alongside in the port of Gibraltar after arriving late last night. Here you may notice numerous anchored vessels around. Many of these ships will not be calling at Gibraltar, instead taking fuel and stores, awaiting berths at the busy container terminal at Algeciras to the west or the oil refinery to the north. Some may simply be anchored in the sheltered bay to escape Atlantic weather systems or awaiting their next set of orders in an ever changing economic climate.

## In the port of Gibraltar.

All Aboard Time: 1.30pm

Few European destinations can boast such a rich combination of history and culture as Gibraltar. Having been governed by the Moors, the Spanish and finally the British, it is not always easy to discern where one influence ends and another begins. During the War of Spanish Succession, Gibraltar was captured in 1704 by British and Dutch forces. For the next 22 years repeated attempts were made by the Spanish to recapture the Rock, along with endless negotiations for peaceful surrender. However, these attempts failed in 1779 when the Spanish made their final and most memorable siege. Assuming the British would be too busy with their troubles in the American War of Independence, the Spanish launched an attack. For three and a half years great privation was experienced by the besieged Gibraltar garrison, which was being repeatedly reinforced by the Royal Navy. The siege finally came to an end in 1783 after a great naval victory by Lord Howe. The majority of Gibraltar's main attractions are located within the Upper Rock Nature Reserve. For a small admission fee, visitors have access to the Moorish Castle, the Ape's Den, St Michael's Cave, the Great Siege Tunnels and the Military Heritage Centre. For the shopper, Moroccan and Indian bazaars trade comfortably alongside British supermarkets and Spanish 'tapas' bars.

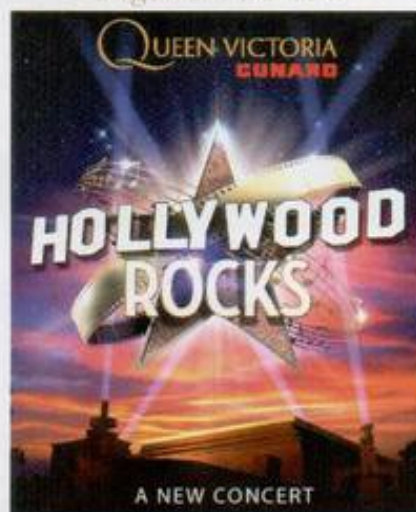

The deadline for sending mail is 2 hours before sailing when the ship is docked, and 3 hours prior if the ship is anchored and using tenders.

## UK Immigration Inspection

Upon arrival to Lisbon tomorrow, the United Kingdom Border Force Authorities will be embarking Queen Victoria to conduct a full face to face inspection on the sea days prior to our arrival back to Southampton. All guests, regardless of nationality, are required to attend as per the time and location detailed in the letter sent to your stateroom. We kindly ask that you come prepared with your passport and guest identification card in order for the inspection to run smoothly. Thank you for your kind cooperation.

## Health advice.

In order to prevent any incidences of viral gastroenteritis (diarrhoea and vomiting) on board, we would respectfully advise our guests to be careful with their personal hygiene, particularly hand washing during their time ashore. If eating and drinking ashore please look for an establishment that appears well maintained and clean and only consume food that has been freshly and thoroughly cooked. It is recommended that you take care when ordering salads which are often washed in local tap water and only drink water from unopened sealed bottles and without ice.

## Guest identification cards.

Please be aware that your Guest ID card is magnetised. These cards can easily become de-magnetised if they are held next to another magnet, for example a credit card, magnets on a handbag, mobile phones, cameras, or if two identification cards are held next to one another.
