## From the Navigator.

Queen Victoria closed on the Portuguese coast in the early hours of this morning, crossing the shallow sandbank or 'Bar' outside the port approaches before embarking our local pilot. We then proceeded to enter the Rio Tejo river, lining up on the leading lights for our approach into Lisbon. Passing under the 'Ponte 25 de Abril' one of the largest suspension bridges in the world, with a total length of 2,277m. This bridge has a nickname of 'The Buzzing Bridge' due to the noise the cars make when driving over the steel gratings that form the deck or road surface of the bridge.

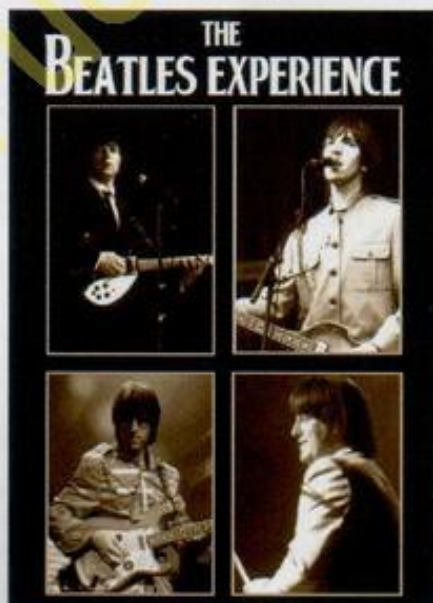

Lisbon, the capital city of Portugal, has become an increasingly popular place to visit in recent years, with a warm Mediterranean climate in spite of its place facing the Atlantic Ocean. Lisbon is one of the oldest cities in the world and the oldest in Western Europe. Full of bleached white limestone buildings and intimate alleyways, Lisbon's mix of traditional architecture and contemporary culture makes it the perfect place for a holiday. There is a lot to see and do in Lisbon. Exploring the city centre will take a few days out of your holiday as there is no real central district, although Praça do Comércio is a good central place to start, in Baixa, or Rossio, the city's main square which has a sort of Trafalgar Square feel to it. Or you might try climbing up the Cristo Rei, a huge statue of Christ with spectacular views across the whole city. The Castelo de São Jorge also offers great views and isn't quite such a steep climb. A short tram ride to the west of Lisbon will also bring you to Belem, where you can explore attractions like the Belem Tower and the Belem Cultural Centre, which features a fantastic art collection including works by Dali, Picasso, Warhol and Magritte. In down town Lisbon, you'll also want to visit the Gulbenkian, which has to be Portugal's answer to the British Museum full of fascinating cultural artefacts and with some superb gardens in the grounds. It's possible to have a fascinating educational holiday in Lisbon, and there are also plenty of great beaches to work on your tan.

## Credit card registration and cash payments for guests disembarking on Monday, 13 November.

We kindly request that all guests disembarking on Monday, 13 November wishing to change the credit card which they have registered against their on board account do so no later than tomorrow, Saturday, 11 November. This will allow sufficient time for the Purser's Office to obtain the necessary authorisation from your issuing bank. We regret that after this deadline we will not be able to accept new credit cards for registration, if you are disembarking on Monday, 13 November, the deadline for making a cash payment to your on board account is 11.00pm, Sunday, 12 November, after which time all charges will be settled to the registered card. No cash will be refunded back to your credit card. Guests disembarking and settling their accounts in cash will need to visit the Purser's Office any time before disembarking on Monday, 13 November to finalise their accounts. Any cash-back and/or foreign exchange is only available for charging to your card up until 11.00pm, Sunday, 12 November, however cash for cash foreign exchange transactions will be available up until the time of disembarkation.

## Crew emergency drill.

At 10.00am this morning alarms will be sounded and broadcasts made as the crew are exercised in their emergency duties. During this exercise limited guest services will be provided. Part of the exercise involves checking guest staterooms to ensure that they have been evacuated. If you prefer not to be disturbed, display the 'Privacy Please' notice prior to the start of the drill. For the duration of the crew drill, we kindly request that guests keep clear of the outside area of the boat deck. Guests are encouraged to broaden their knowledge of maritime safety by watching the programme shown on TV Channel 48 between 9.00am and 12.00pm.

## UK Immigration Inspection.

Upon arrival to Lisbon today, the United Kingdom Border Force Authorities will be embarking Queen Victoria to conduct a full face to face inspection on the sea days prior to our arrival back to Southampton. All guests, regardless of nationality, are required to attend as per the time and location detailed in the letter sent to your stateroom. We kindly ask that you come prepared with your passport and guest identification card in order for the inspection to run smoothly. Thank you for your kind cooperation.

## Security and safety ashore (pickpockets).

Whilst we do not wish to restrict your movements ashore today and in our upcoming ports, we do suggest taking the following precautions:

- Do not stray from the main tourist areas.
- Do not wear any jewellery that is likely to attract attention.
- Gentlemen should not carry their wallets in their back pockets and ladies should have their handbags zipped and close to them at all times, ensuring that your personal items are secure and not visible or accessible to pickpockets.
- You are strongly advised not to take your passport ashore unless it is required for something specific, we recommend using another form of photographic identification.
- We advise you to be extremely careful if you are taking any high value items, including cameras ashore.
- Maintain an awareness of your surroundings.
- Please be extra vigilant if approached by strangers.
